

EyeGuardian's specifically formulated mild adhesive provides a consistent, even pressure on the eye. This not only reduces bruising, eliminates eyelash removal and minimises disease transmission, but it also helps the cornea stay moist throughout, preventing corneal abrasion. The purple tab allows access to the eyes at any time for checking and maintaining eye condition.

Taping patients eyes during anaesthesia does not provide adequate protection. This practice is not recommended by the AfPP, which notes;

"The corneas should be protected by ensuring the eyelids are closed. Eye pads specifically designed for this purpose can be used.

Additional consideration should be given to patients who are undergoing procedures requiring a prone position. The use of tape, other than securing the eye pads, is not recommended as it may cause damage to the eyelid". (Afpp, Standards and Recommendations for Safe Perioperative Practice 2022)
